THE KICKSTART SCHEME PROVIDES FUNDING TO EMPLOYERS TO CREATE NEW 6-MONTH JOB PLACEMENTS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE 16-24 WHO **ARE CURRENTLY ON UNIVERSAL CREDIT AND** AT RISK OF LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYMENT.

Government funding will cover for each job placement:

- > 100% of the relevant National Minimum Wage for 25 hours a week
- > the associated employer National Insurance contributions
- > employer minimum automatic enrolment contributions

The training and development should:

- > Support the young person into employment
- > Support career development

There will also be extra funding at the start of their employment (£1500) to support young people to build their experience, and help them move into sustained employment after they have completed their Kickstart Scheme job placement

The job placements created with the Kickstart funding must be new jobs. They must not:

- > Replace existing or planned vacancies
- > Cause existing employees or contractors to lose or reduce their employment
- > Replace recent redundancies
